### outlining some of the work to be undertaken during 2016

One of our main items of expenditure is the replacement of footway street lighting which has resulted in the Council making carefully considered decisions on which projects they can resolve. The lighting is an ongoing project with eleven lights to be replaced.

A bid was also submitted to upgrade paving within the village at a cost of £10,000, the Parish Council contributing £1500 we were successful in this bid, with only ten projects approved across Fenland for this year. Other work will also be carried out by Cambridgeshire County Council Highways Department in response to a Parish Council initiative.

The Parish Council are constantly aware of work that requires attention and carefully considers projects to be taken forward within the restraints of our budget.

### **During 2015/2016**

During the last year we held six Parish Council meetings and all councillors attended on a regular basis.

The Council has made recommendations on ten planning applications. Councillors have met with the Highways Department officer to discuss relevant highway issues

We continue to provide fifteen allotments all of which are presently rented out. Our local Post Office closed on 29<sup>th</sup> July however an agreement was reached to use the village hall on a Thursday morning which is manned by a Post Office official

The bus shelter in Goodens Lane has been enhanced by children from Kinderley School with the assistance of a resident from our village.

The Parish Council monitors and carries out work within the village where appropriate. The Council also works with the Probation Service to carry out minor maintenance tasks within the village.

Further Speedwatch training will soon be undertaken with volunteers to continue to monitor the speed of vehicles through the village.

The Village Plan was undertaken by a group of volunteers who collated and distributed a questionnaire on various aspects to every household in the Parish asking for their views. The response to the survey was extremely supportive. The group compiled all the results, two of the most significant answers raised from the survey were:

The change of the village name from Newton to Newton in the Isle, this has already been achieved and approved by Fenland District Council. The Parish Council has also organised the replacement village signs.

A request for a defibrillator was also an important issue, with village support this has been achieved.

Work has already commenced with six bracket lights upgraded at a cost of £3716 already funded by the Parish Council along with a contribution of £1500 towards the Highways Bid for new paving.
